



NOTICE OF RACE

EURO 4000 SOCIETE DES REGATES DE SAINT-PIERRE QUIBERON GRADE 3 26th to 29th of July at the E.N.V.S.N.

The mention [NP] in a *rule* means that a boat cannot protest (No protest) against another boat when infringing this *rule*. This amends RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a *rule* means that the penalty for a breach of that *rule* may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

Preamble

Prevention of violence and incivility.

The FFVoile recalls that sporting events are above all, a space for exchanges and sharing open and accessible to all.

As such, competitors, their legal representatives and their guests are asked to behave in all circumstances, on land and on the water, in a courteous and respectful manner regardless of the origin, gender or sexual orientation of other participants.

Following the aggression of Ukraine, the FFVoile decided on March 2, 2022 not to authorize the participation of Russian and Belarusian competitors in competitions throughout France.

1. RACE RULES

The test is governed by:

1.1 - the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*,

1.2 - National requirements, translated for non-French speaking competitors, in joined appendix named "prescriptions".

- 1.4 Class rules
- 1.5 In case of translation of this NoR, the French text will prevail.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

- 2.1 The SIs will be available on the 25th of july 2023 after 09H00 on the SRSP website.
- 2.2 The SIs will be displayed according to FFVoile requirement.

3.2 [DP] [NP] From the 1st warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat, while racing, shall not transmit nor receive any voice or data informations that are not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

In accordance with RRS76.1, the organizers will reject or cancel the entry of any competitor of Russian or Belarusian nationality or displaying these nationalities, and the participation of any boat whose owner or manager is a Russian or Belarusian individual or entity.

4.1 The event is open to 4000 class boats.

Documents required upon registration:

a) For competitors who hold a FFVoile Club license:

the license must show the "Competition" status (which confirms the medical ability fort racing in competition)

or

the valid FFVoile club licence with "Adhesion" or "Pratique" status, accompanied with

for competitor under 18 yoa, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the said competitor

for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

b) For each competitor without a FFVoile Club license, whether foreign or French national living abroad :

a proof of membership of a World Sailing Member national authority.

a proof of a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 million Euros.

for under 18 yos, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the said competitor or, for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition

c) a parental authorization for any 18 yoa competitor.

4.2.2 For the sailing boat:

- the measurement form or rating certificate of the boat, when its presentation is required by a rule

- if necessary a valid authorization to display advertising on the boat

Competitors and their eligible boats can register online until the 20th of july 2023.

4.5 To be considered as registered in the event, a boat must meet all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5. FEES

5.1 The entry fees are as follows:

Included in the entry fee are : a gift for each team members (which will be distributing upon physical registration, a welcome drink on the 26^{th} of July and a racers dinner at the ENVSN on the evening of the 28^{th} of July.

6. ADVERTISING

6.1 [DP] [NP] Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

[DP] [NP] The organizing authority may provide race bibs that competitors are required to wear as authorized by World Sailing advertising Code.

7.3 Number of races: up to 5 races per day

7.4 On the last scheduled racing day, no warning will be given after 15H00.

8 EQUIPMENT CONTROLS:

- 8.1 A crews' weight will take place at the time of confirmation of registration.
- 9 **LOCATIONS:** see appendix A
- 10 **REGATTA ROUTES:** they will be of the built route type. They will be described in the Sis.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is amended to replace the two-turns penalty with the one-turn penalty.

12 SCORING

12.1 4 races must be completed to validate the regatta.

12.2 a) When less than 5 races have been validated, the score of a boat will be the total score of all its races.

b) When 5 to 8 races have been validated, the score of a boat in a series will be the total of the scores of its races excluding its worst score.

c) When 9 or more races have been validated, the score of a boat in a series will be the total of the scores of its races excluding its two worst scores.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

[DP] Support boats must be identified by a white pennant.

14 PLACES AT THE PORT

[DP] [NP] Boats must remain in their assigned spaces while remaining in the boat park

15 DATA PROTECTION

15.1 Image and appearance rights : Participating in the competition, the competitor and his legal representative authorize the OA, the FFVoile and their sponsors to use free of charge his image and his name, to show at any time (during and after the competition) static or moving pictures, films or TV recording, as well as other reproduction from himself done during the competition, and this on any support and for any use related to the promotion of their activities.

15.2 Use of personal data of participants: Participating in this competition, the competitor and his legal representatives agree to and authorize the FFVoile, its sponsors, as well as the OA to use and store, free of charge, his personal data. These data may be published by FFVoile and its sponsors. The FFVoile mainly, but also its sponsors may use these data for the development of softwares or with marketing purposes. In accordance with the « Règlement Général sur la Protection des Données (RGPD) » (General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)), any competitor having transmitted his personal data to the FFVoile, may exercice his right to access to his own data, have them modified, and, depending on the situations, have them deleted, limited, or to object them, sending an email to dpo@ffvoile.fr or a letter to the Head Office of the Fédération Française de Voile, mentioning that the request is related to personal data.

16 **RECOGNITION OF RISKS**

RRS 3 mentions: « The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. » Participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledge the fact that sailing is potentially a dangerous activity with specific risks. These risks include strong winds and rough sea, sudden changes of weather conditions, failure of equipment, mistakes in boat handling, bad navigation of other boats, loss of balance on unstable surface, and causing increased risk of injury. The risk of material and/or physical damage is therefore inherent in the sport of sailing.

FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2021-2024 translated for non-francophone competitors

FFVoile Prescription to RRS 25.1 (Notice of race, sailing instructions and signals):

For events graded 4 and 5, standard notices of race and sailing instructions including the specificities of the event shall be used. Events graded 4 may have dispensation for such requirement, after receipt of FFVoile approval, received before the notice of race has been published.

For events graded 5, posting of sailing instructions will be considered as meeting the requirements of RRS 25.1 application.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 64.4** (Decisions on protests concerning class rules):

The protest committee may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 67 (Damages):

Any question or request related to damages arising from an incident occurred while a boat was bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing depends on the appropriate courts and cannot be examined and dealt by a protest committee.

A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, by that such action, admit liability for damages.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 70. 5 (Appeals and requests to a national authority):

The denial of the right of appeal is subject to the written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile, received before publishing the notice of race. This approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to **RRS 76.1** (Exclusion of boats or competitors)

An organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the notice of race and sailing instructions for an arbitrary reason.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 78.1 (Compliance with class rules; certificates):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat complies with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 86.3 (Changes to the racing rules):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1(a) in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such approval shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 88.2 (Changes to prescriptions):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall not be changed in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website www.ffvoile.fr, shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

(*) FFVoile Prescription to RRS 91(b) (Protest committee):

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile. Such approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
